On Thursday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, S4 Inc. President and CEO **Chandu Shah** took part in a “Boss Lift” orientation flight aboard a UH-60 Black Hawk MEDEVAC helicopter from Millard Airport, Omaha, Nebraska. Sponsored by the Employer Support of the Guard & Reserve (ESGR), this invite-only event was organized to appreciate Employers who support Guard and Reserve service members in the Omaha area.

It turned out to be a great morning for the Boss Lift. The morning started with a briefing from Major General Daryl Bohac, Nebraska Adjutant General, on the capabilities of the Nebraska Army and Air National Guard, and the support provided during the historic flooding in 2019. ESGR volunteers also gave briefings on ESGR and what they do for employees and employers. Lastly came a safety briefing from one of the crew chiefs/medics, then out to the flight line and aircraft. Chandu went out on the first sortie and had a 30 minute flight around the Omaha metropolitan area. In all they did six sorties with five employers on each flight.
